#### 4. Way forward

This issue has been raised at the INSARAG Steering Group (ISG) Meeting 2016 in Geneva for consideration, and it was recommended that, in consultation with the regions and relevant stakeholders, it should continue to be discussed in the regional and team leaders' meeting in 2016.

The key discussion points are:

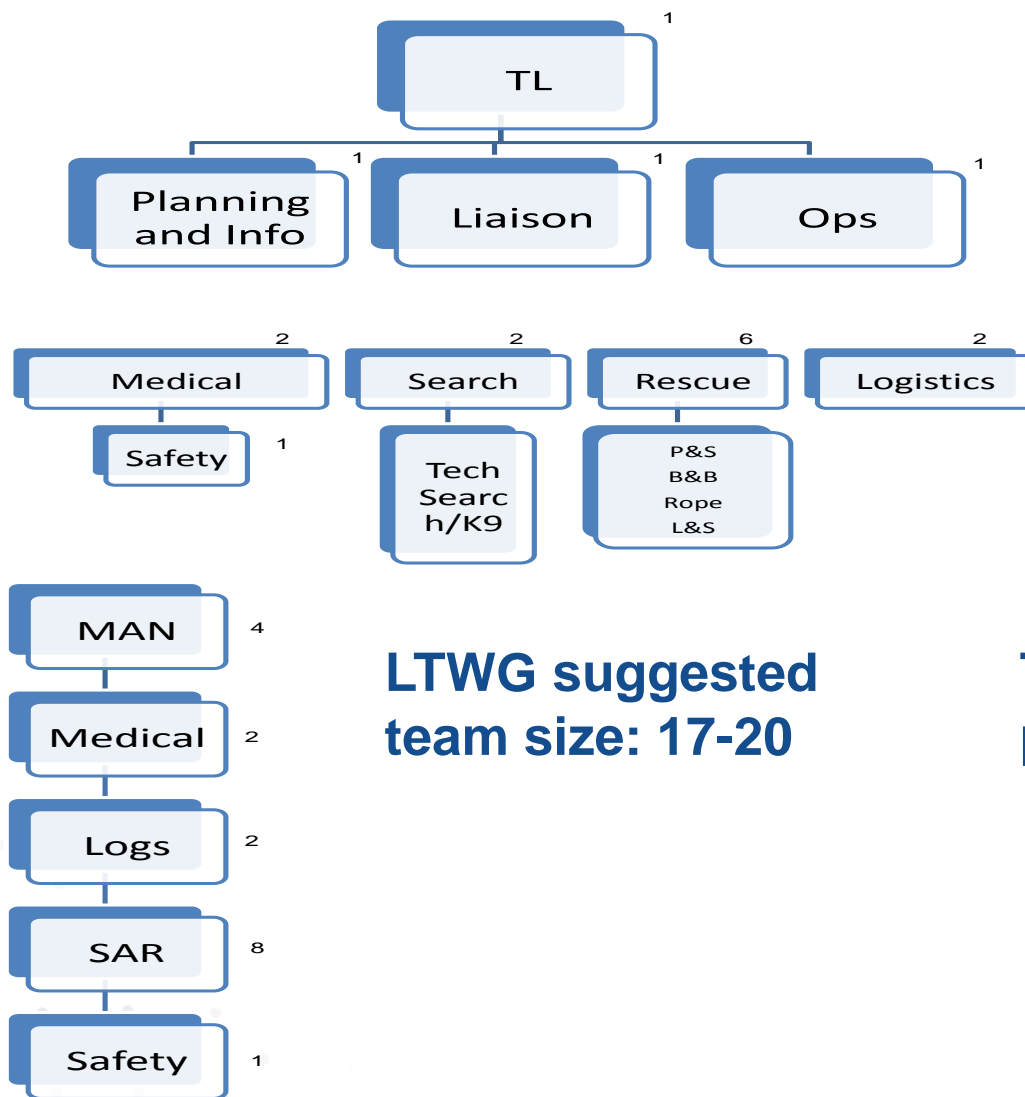
1. It is recognised that these are teams that do not necessarily fall under 'Heavy' or 'Medium' based on the INSARAG Guidelines; they could be 'specialised' teams on their own, or composed of downsized Heavy or Medium teams. Such teams should be deployed to support particular functions, such as the running of OSOCC and RDC.
2. Specialised teams should abide by the INSARAG principles and minimum standards, such as the reporting and coordination requirements. Quality assurance of these teams could be achieved through a third party evaluation mechanism (e.g. EU mechanism) and could be done regionally.
3. Specialised teams should not be INSARAG classified so to ensure that no further pressure is placed on the IEC/IER system.

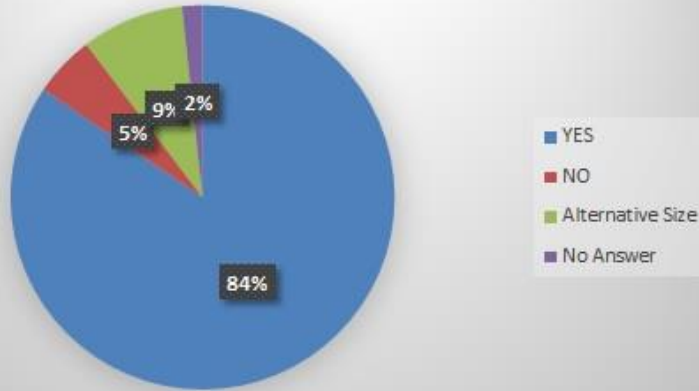

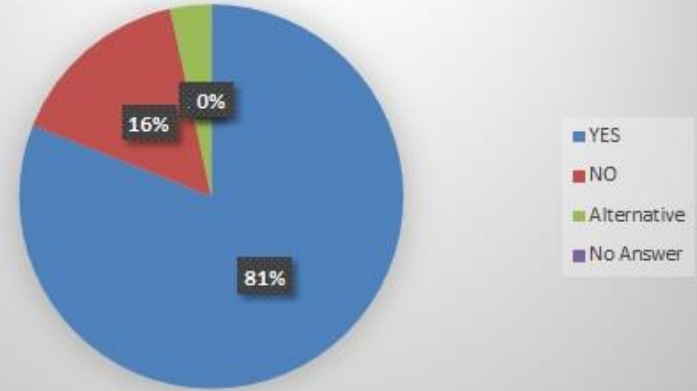

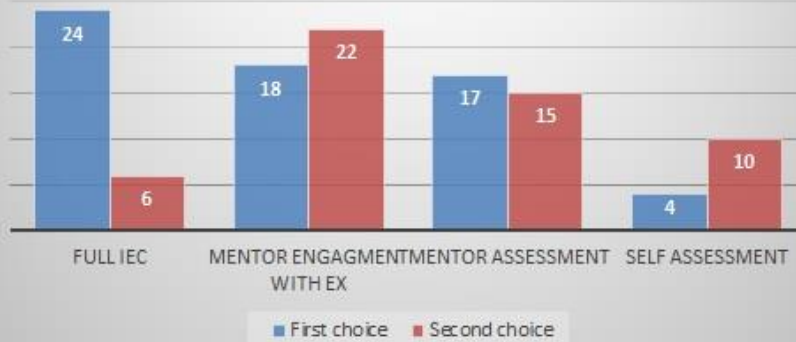
### Int. Light Team size 17 - 20



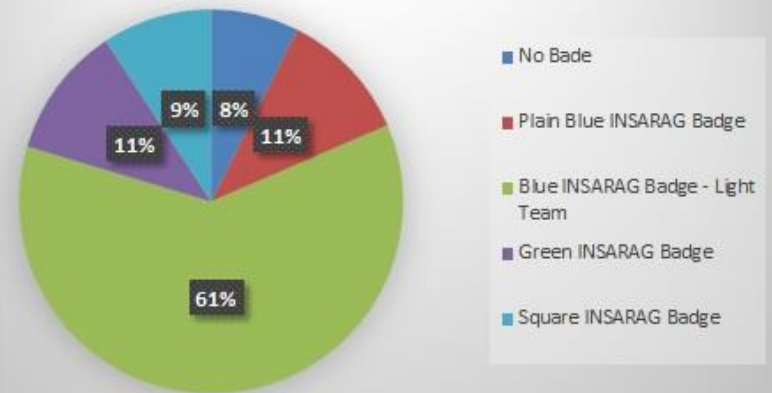
### Int. Light Team add value

- Adjust the concept paper on basis of Team Leaders meeting about design of capability, tasks and configuration of International Light teams.
- Presentation in regional meetings about the design, quality assurance and governance of International Light teams.
- Prepare a final proposal for the INSARAG Steering Group meeting in 2017 to decide if and how International Light Teams should be part of the INSARAG system and guidelines.
- Prepare a final paper on the decision of the I.S.G. which can be added to the Guidelines by the Guidelines Revision Group on Volume I, II (B&C), and III.
- Assist the Training Working Group with the design of a training package for International Light teams.
- Ajustar documento de concepto con base en Reunión TL sobre diseño de capacidad, tareas y configuración de un Equipos Liviano internacional
- Presentación en Reuniones regionales sobre diseño, control de calidad y gobernanza de equipos livianos internacionales
